As we read through the book of Genesis, we will look for these names: Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Judah. These are people in the family from which Jesus came.

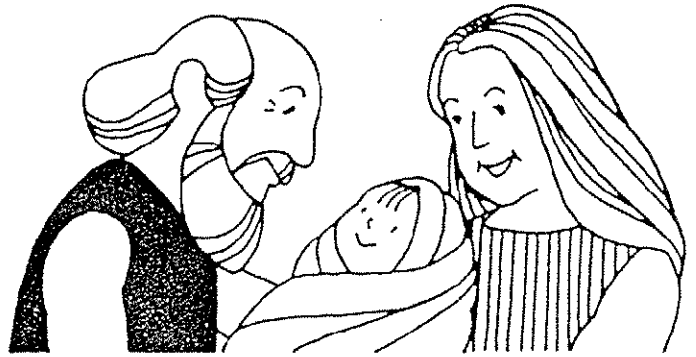
