Segment: 3 Jesus Performs Miracles

Lesson #: 1-2

Lesson Title: Faithful Friends/Through the Roof

Scripture: Matthew 9:1-8, Mark 2:1-12, Luke 5:17-26

Memory Work:

Teacher Asks: What did Jesus say about His miracles?

Student Answers: John 4:48 Jesus said to the people of Galilee "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you will by no means believe."

Goals and Objectives:

The children will learn that:

- *Jesus is able to heal people.
- *Faithful friends helped the paralyzed man get to Jesus.
- *Jesus is able to forgive sins.

Application from Lesson:

- 1. God is pleased when we help our friends.
- 2. Nothing is beyond the power of Christ.

Materials Needed:

- 1. Copy pages from folder to make story book "Faithful Friends" ,<u>The Big Book of Bible Story Mini-Books.</u>
- 2. Watercolor paints, q-tips or brushes
- 3. Copy cardstock house, cot, man
- 4. Crayons

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Allow each student to say memory verse upon entering class. Complete attendance chart.
- 2. Have pre-class activity ready to work on.
- 3. Sing "It's Time for Bible Class".
- 4. Sing "God is Listening".
- 5. Open class with prayer. Let students take turns praying.
- 6. Introduce Bible lesson. Talk about miracles and how only Jesus could perform these miracles.
- 7. Talk about how this lesson comes from the NT.
- 8. Sing the books of the NT.
- 9. Sing the 39+27= 66 song.
- 10. Read The Beginner's Bible, story "Through the Roof" p.326
- 11. Talk about the miracle Jesus performed and how the paralyzed man's friend helped him get to Jesus.
- 12. Use the puppets and props to retell the story, allow children to help.
- 13. If time allows act out the story.
- 14. Complete the different crafts for each class. (see below)

Explanation of Craft:

<u>Lesson 1</u> – Watercolor the mini-storybook.

<u>Lesson 2</u> – Make cardstock house, man on cot, attach string to cot to raise and lower through roof. Color pieces.

Lesson #: 3-4

Lesson Title: Jesus Calms the Storm

Scripture: Matthew 8:23-27, Mark 4:35-41, Luke 8:22-25

Memory Work:

Teacher Asks: What did Jesus say about His miracles?

Student Answers: John 4:48 Jesus said to the people of Galilee "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you will by no means believe."

Goals and Objectives:

The children will learn that:

- *Jesus is able to control the weather.
- *the disciples were afraid and thought they were going to die in the storm.
- *the disciples were amazed at the power of Christ.
- *Jesus admonished the disciples lack of faith.

Application from Lesson:

- 1. When we are afraid we must trust God.
- 2. Nothing is beyond the power of Christ.

Materials Needed:

- 1. Copied mini-book pages
- 2. Crayons
- 3. Card stock boat, sail, Jesus
- 4. Glue
- 5. Blue construction paper

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Allow each student to say memory verse upon entering class. Place sticker or attendance chart.
- 2. Have pre-class activity ready to work on.
- 3. Sing opening song to welcome children.
- 4. Sing "God is Listening".
- 5. Teacher lead prayer and let students take turns praying.
- 6. Talk about the disciples and how they helped Jesus.
- 7. Sing the "Apostles Song", use apostle puppet props while singing.
- 8. Read from the Beginner's Bible, "Wind and Waves" p. 363.
- 9. Review miracle from past lessons, talk about this new miracle of Jesus controlling the weather and how He is always there to protect us.
- 10. Complete the craft.
- 11. Let the children act out the story emphasizing Jesus was in control and they did not need to be afraid.

Lesson Title: Jesus Feeds 5,000

Scripture: Matthew 14:15-21, Mark 6:35-44, Luke 9:12-17, John 6:5-14

Memory Work:

Teacher Asks: What did Jesus say about His miracles?

Student Answers: John 4:48 Jesus said to the people of Galilee "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you will by no means believe."

Goals and Objectives:

The children will learn that:

- *Jesus was able to feed more than 5,000 people and have food left over.
- *Jesus showed compassion toward the people.
- *Jesus gave thanks to God.
- *one boy shared his lunch.

Application from Lesson:

- 1. All things are possible through Christ.
- 2. God is happy when we share.
- 3. We must always remember to thank God for our blessings.

Materials Needed:

- 1. Cardstock mini-book pages.
- 2. Watercolors
- 3. Cardstock Jesus feeds 5,000 take home props.
- 4. Baskets, fish, loaves of bread props from resource room to use for storytelling.

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Allow each student to say memory verse upon entering class and place sticke on attendance chart.
- 2. Have pre-class activity ready to work on.
- 3. Teacher will pray and allow students to pray.
- 4. Sing various welcoming songs.
- 5. Read "The Big Picnic" in the Beginner's Bible.
- 6. Talk about how Jesus provided for their needs and he thanked God for giving them enough to eat.
- 7. Use props to retell and act out story.
- 8. Point out how Jesus abundantly provided and baskets were leftover of food.
- 9. Sing apostles song and 39+27=66 song.
- 8. Complete story craft.

Memory Work:

Teacher Asks: What did Jesus say about His miracles?

Student Answers: John 4:48 Jesus said to the people of Galilee "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you will by no means believe."

Goals and Objectives:

The children will learn that:

- *Jesus was able to walk on water.
- *Jesus was able to save Peter who took his eyes off the Lord.
- *Jesus is able to control the weather.

Application from Lesson:

- 1. When we are afraid we must focus on Jesus.
- 2. God is control of everything.
- 3. Jesus is the Son of God.

Materials Needed:

- 1. Copy coloring page.
- 2. Watercolors or crayons.
- 3. Copy cardstock prop of Jesus walks on water.
- 4. Yarn

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Allow each student to say memory verse upon entering class and place sticke on attendance chart.
- 2. Have pre-class activity ready to work on.
- 3. Open class with prayer. Let students take a turn praying.
- 4. Sing various welcoming songs. Use various props with songs.
- 5. Sing apostles song use apostle prop.
- 6. Intro. lesson and how Jesus performs another miracle by walking on water.
- 7. Review other miracles in lessons 1-6 use picture cards on wall.
- 8. Tell story with picture cards.
- 9. Talk about lessons learned from story. See application section.
- 10. Complete craft lesson 7 coloring page or lesson 8 card stock prop.
- 11. Act out story if time allows.

Goals and Objectives:

The children will learn that:

- *Jesus was able to heal lepers that no one else could help.
- *Jesus was able to heal by just speaking.
- *Jesus showed compassion and gave help to those who were sick.
- *only one leper said thank you.

Application from Lesson:

- 1. It is important to thank God for our blessings.
- 2. All things are possible with Christ.
- 3. We must be kind and show compassion like Christ to others.

Materials Needed:

- 1. Story cards.
- 2. Copy mini-storybook
- 3. Copy card stock prop of Ten Lepers

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Allow each student to say memory verse upon entering class and place sticke on attendance chart.
- 2. Have pre-class activity ready to work on.
- 3. Open class with prayer. Let students take a turn praying.
- 4. Sing various welcoming songs.
- 5. Sing "A Helper I will be"
- 6. Talk about how the apostles helped Jesus and how we can help Jesus.
- 7. Sing the apostles song. Use apostle props.

Goals and Objectives:

The children will learn that:

- *Jesus had the power to heal a blind man.
- *Jesus showed compassion and gave help to those who were sick.
- *Jesus healed the blind man to show the work of God in his life.

Application from Lesson:

- 1. All things are possible with Christ.
- 2. We must be kind and show compassion like Christ to others.
- 3. We must obey exactly what Christ tells us to do.
