### Memory Work:

**Teacher Asks:** What did Jesus teach?

**Student Answers:** John 5:14&16 Ye are the light of the world... Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

# **Goals and Objectives:**

### The children will learn that:

- \*Jesus tells how to be a godly example to others that observe our behavior.
- \*Jesus says not to worry and believe God will provide.
- \*Jesus says to seek His kingdom and to please God.

### **Application from Lesson:**

- 1. God takes care of us, so we must not worry about our food or clothing.
- 2. Nothing is beyond the power of Christ. We must trust God.
- 3. The blessings in our lives show how God loves us.

**Teacher Asks:** What did Jesus teach?

**Student Answers:** John 5:14&16 Ye are the light of the world... Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

# **Goals and Objectives:**

### The children will learn that:

- \*Jesus tells how to be part of God's kingdom.
- \*Jesus says that listening to and obeying God's word makes a person wise.
- \*the wise man built his house on Christ and the foolish man built his house on unwise things of this world.

### **Application from Lesson:**

- 1. God wants to be the focus of our lives.
- 2. Building our lives and choices on Christ is wise.
- 3. If our hearts are built on Christ we will be able to face trials with faith.
