Segment: 6 Jesus Gives Salvation

Lesson #: 1-2**Lesson Title:** **The Saddest Day (Crucifixion)/ The Happiest Day (Resurrection)**Scripture: Matthew 27, 28: 1-17, Mark 15, 16: 1-13, Luke 23, 24:1-43,
John 19, 20

Memory Work:

Teacher Asks: How can a man be saved?**Student Answers:** John 3:5 Jesus said, ... "unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God."**Goals and Objectives:****The children will learn that:**

- *God's plan was fulfilled with the crucifixion of Christ.
- *scripture was fulfilled with His death and His resurrection.
- *Jesus died for the sins of all people.

Application from Lesson:

1. God's plan was fulfilled by Jesus.
2. We can trust God, because He keeps His promises.
3. Jesus' death was full of suffering.
4. God showed His love for us through the sacrifice of His Son.

Lesson 1: story wheel : round paper with story in pie pieces. Have children color them then attach construction paper circle with one pie piece. Cut out with brad so they can turn it to show story.

Lesson Title: Great Commission & Ascension

Scripture: Matthew 28: 16-20, Mark 16: 14-20, Luke 24: 44-53, Acts 1

Memory Work:

Teacher Asks: How can a man be saved?

Student Answers: John 3:5 Jesus said, ... "unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God."

Goals and Objectives:

The children will learn that:

*Jesus told His disciples to go into all the world and preach the truth and baptism.

*Jesus ascended to heaven to be with God.

Application from Lesson:

1. God wants us to share the truth with others.
2. Jesus died and arose to life again and is living with God in heaven, just like the scripture said it would happen.
3. We should want to share the love of Christ with everyone we know.

Scripture: Acts 2

Memory Work:**Teacher Asks:** How can a man be saved?**Student Answers:** John 3:5 Jesus said, ... "unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God."**Goals and Objectives:****The children will learn that:**

*Jesus told the apostles that the Holy Spirit would come upon them, and this was fulfilled on the Day of Pentecost.

*the apostles were given the power to speak many different languages.

*scripture from the prophet Joel and David were fulfilled by the events of Pentecost and the death of Christ.

*Peter told the people on the Day of Pentecost, repent and be baptized.

*Christians added to the church continued to worship, fellowship, break bread together, and pray.

Application from Lesson:

1. God is all powerful. All things are possible with Christ.
2. When we realize we have done wrong we must say sorry to God.
3. God requires obedience from us. (baptism and living a Christian life)
4. God wants us to worship together and love Him together.

Memory Work:

Teacher Asks: How can a man be saved?**Student Answers:** John 3:5 Jesus said, ... "unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God."**Goals and Objectives:****The children will learn that:**

*Philip preached Jesus to the Ethiopian eunuch.

*the eunuch was baptized after hearing about Jesus.

*the Spirit of the Lord took Philip away after the baptism of the eunuch.

Application from Lesson:

*When we hear the truth we should obey it.

*We should be willing to teach all people the truth.

*Christ died to wash away our sins.

*Baptism is necessary to be saved.

Scripture: Acts 9: 1-22

Memory Work:

Teacher Asks: How can a man be saved?**Student Answers:** John 3:5 Jesus said, ... "unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God."**Goals and Objectives:****The children will learn that:**

- *Saul ruthlessly persecuted Christians.
- *Saul was chosen by God to serve Him and others.
- *Saul was told to obey and he did.
- *Saul was blinded by the Lord.
- *Saul's vision was returned by Ananias laying hands on him.
- *Saul was baptized.
- *Saul changed and began preaching the truth about Christ.

Application from Lesson:

- *We must be willing to see we are wrong and sinful.
- *Even the greatest sinner can be forgiven.
- *When we hear the truth we should obey it.
- *When the gift of salvation is given to us, we should share it with others.

Materials Needed:

Lesson 9: copy story wheel and coloring page.

Lesson 10: copied story pictures, 3 hole punch, construction paper, glue, ribbon to tie book together.

Order of Activities and Songs:

1. Allow each student to say memory verse upon entering class.
2. Have pre-class activity ready to work on.
3. Open class with prayer. Let students take a turn praying.
4. Sing books of the Bible.
5. Tell story. (show story on i-pad)
6. Craft activity.
7. Review lesson.
8. Close class with songs

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Lesson #: 11-12**Lesson Title:** Peter and Cornelius

Scripture: Acts 10

Memory Work:

Teacher Asks: How can a man be saved?**Student Answers:** John 3:5 Jesus said, ... "unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God."**Goals and Objectives:****The children will learn that:**

*Cornelius was a devout man.

*God told Cornelius to go find Peter (Simon) in Joppa.

*Peter realized in a message from God that He wanted the gentiles to be saved also.

*After Peter preached to truth to all those present, they were baptized and added to the church.

Application from Lesson:

1. God shows no partiality and wants all people to be saved.
2. Hearing the truth and be being baptized pleases God.
3. We should be willing to share the truth with everyone.

Materials Needed:

Lesson 11: coloring sheet, blue tissue paper, boxes, copied picture of Peter and men.

Order of Activities and Songs:

1. Allow each student to say memory verse upon entering class.

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Lesson #: 13**Lesson Title:** Paul, Silas, and the Philippian Jailer

Scripture: Acts 10: 16-40

Memory Work:

Teacher Asks: How can a man be saved?**Student Answers:** John 3:5 Jesus said, ... "unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God."**Goals and Objectives:****The children will learn that:**

- *a demon possessed girl told her masters that Paul and Silas were servants of God.
- *Paul commanded the demon to come out of the girl.
- *the girl's masters were angry because they profited from the demon possessed girl.
- *the masters had them arrested.
- *in jail they sang and prayed to God.
- *an earthquake released their chains and opened the doors of the jail.
- *because Paul and Silas did not run away the jailer asked to be saved.
- *the jailer and all his family were baptized.

Application from Lesson:

1. God is in control.
2. God can use bad events for His good purposes.
3. We should be willing to share the truth with all people.
4. When we are afraid, we can pray and sing to God.
