Lesson #: 1

Lesson Title: The Great Fish: Jonah Runs from God

Scripture: Jonah 1-2

Memory Work: OT Books

Memory Verse: "... For He is the living God, and steadfast forever..." Daniel 6:26

(Goals and Objectives)

The children will learn:

- 1. God had an important job for Jonah, but Jonah was scared
- 2. Jonah tried to hide from God, but God kept him safe
- 3. Jonah obeyed God and told the people of Nineveh to stop sinning
- 4. The people believed Jonah and God saved them

Application from Lesson:

God will take care of us if we TRUST and OBEY Him

Materials Needed:

Felt board and story pieces
Jonah and the Big Fish booklet pages
Crayons or Watercolors, cup of water and q-tips

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Have children work on puzzles until class begins
- 2. Let each child put a sticker on their attendance chart
- 3. Have each child say the memory verse and put a sticker on their chart
- 4. Review the OT books of the bible (sing song)
- 5. Say a prayer (If any children want to lead a prayer let them)
- Tell the story of Jonah and the big fish while using the felt board, stressing that Jonah was scared and didn't want to obey God, but finally trusted in God
- 7. Let children color book pages while discussing the story again

Explanation of Craft:

Before the class, photocopy the booklet pages. After telling the story, let each child color the book pages and then staple the pages together.

Lesson #: 2

Lesson Title: The Priest: Jehoiada Teaches King Joash

Scripture: 2 Kings 11:1 – 12:16

Memory Work: OT Books

Memory Verse: "... For He is the living God, and steadfast forever..." Daniel 6:26

(Goals and Objectives)

The children will learn:

- 1. Joash's uncle Jehoiada taught him about God's laws
- 2. Joash became king at 7 years old
- 3. Joash ordered that money be collected to repair the Temple of God
- 4. People donated money and the Temple was repaired

Application from Lesson:

When we obey God and follow his commands, we can be a good influence on others.

Materials Needed:

Plastic "gold" coins

A box for collecting the coins

Crumpled newspaper and other "trash" for the children to clean up

Cardboard bricks

Plastic hammers and/or saws

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Have children work on puzzles until class begins
- 2. Let each child put a sticker on their attendance chart
- Have each child say the memory verse and put a sticker on their chart
- 4. Review the OT books of the bible (sing song)
- 5. Say a prayer (If any children want to lead a prayer let them)
- 6. Read the children the story of Jehoiada and Joash
- 7. Spread the "trash" around the classroom
- 8. Give each child a few coins and let them take turns dropping the coins in the collection box
- 9. Let the children clean up the trash and use their hammers (on bricks or the floor or table) to repair the temple
- 10. Sing "I Want to Be a Worker for the Lord"
- 11. If there's time, the children can do a coloring page

The Rescue: Hezekiah Trusts the Lord

Scripture: 2 Kings 18-19

Memory Work: OT Books

Memory Verse: "... For He is the living God, and steadfast forever..." Daniel 6:26

(Goals and Objectives)

The children will learn:

- 1. Hezekiah was a good king and he repaired the temple in Jerusalem
- 2. Then Hezekiah invited everyone to the Passover feast
- 3. When the bad King of Assyria threatened Hezekiah
- 4. Hezekiah trusted and prayed to God and He protected the people

Application from Lesson:

We should trust in the Lord and ask him to help us

Materials Needed:

Papers for "trash"
Plastic hammers and/or saws
Fake food

Small paper cups of water for each child

Connect-the-dots praying hands worksheet

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Have children work on puzzles until class begins
- 2. Let each child put a sticker on their attendance chart
- 3. Have each child say the memory verse and put a sticker on their chart
- 4. Review the OT books of the bible (sing song)

Scripture: 2 Kings 22:1-23:3

Memory Work: OT Books

Memory Verse: "... For He is the living God, and steadfast forever..." Daniel 6:26

(Goals and Objectives)

The children will learn:

- 1. King Josiah wanted to repair the temple
- 2. A book of God's Laws was found and shown to Josiah
- 3. Josiah read the book to the people and they all promised to obey God
- 4. Josiah destroyed all of the idols and ordered that they celebrate Passover
- 5. Josiah loved God and obeyed his laws

Application from Lesson:

God wants us to follow his commands

Materials Needed:

Picture story page with clip art
Josiah Finds the Bible book coloring pages (use to tell the story)
Paper made into scrolls and tied with string for the children to find

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Have children work on puzzles until class begins
- 2. Let each child put a sticker on their attendance chart
- 3. Have each child say the memory verse and put a sticker on their chart
- 4. Review the OT books of the bible (sing song)
- 5. Say a prayer (If any children want to lead a prayer let them)
- 6. Read story Josiah Finds the Bible (Use coloring pages to tell the story)

Memory Work: **OT Books**

(Goals and Objectives)

The children will learn:

- 1. God's people stopped worshipping him and began worshipping idols
- 2. The Babylonians destroyed the Jerusalem and made God's people slaves
- 3. The King of Judah had forgotten all that God had done for them, so God did not help them

Application from Lesson:

We should love God and remember all that He has done for us

Materials Needed:

"Northern and Southern Kingdoms" books to color crayons or watercolor paint, cup of water and q-tips yarn to gently tie children's hands

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Have children work on puzzles until class begins
- 2. Let each child put a sticker on their attendance chart
- 3. Have each child say the memory verse and put a sticker on their chart
- 4. Review the OT books of the bible (sing song)
- 5. Say a prayer (If any children want to lead a prayer let them)
- 6. Read story
- 7. Have each child stand up and gently tie their hands together with yarn
- 8. Tell them they now have to serve King Nebuchadnezzar and
- 9. Quietly lead them down the hall and back
- 10. Ask them how they would feel if someone took them from their home

Lesson Title: The Vegetables: Daniel Eats Good Food

Scripture: Daniel 1

Memory Work: OT Books

Memory Verse: "... For He is the living God, and steadfast forever..." Daniel 6:26

(Goals and Objectives) The children will learn:

- 1. Daniel and 3 of his friends were taken to the palace with other men
- 2. The young men were given all kinds of yummy food and drinks
- 3. Daniel loved God and knew He would not want them to eat the unhealthy food
- 4. Daniel asked the king's helper to let them have vegetables and water for 10 days and they ended up stronger and healthier
- 5. God helped Daniel make the right choice

Application from Lesson:

We should ask God to help us to make good choices

Materials Needed:

Plastic vegetables and fruit
A piece of cardstock for each child
Clip art of different vegetables and also junk food, cut out
Glue stick for each child

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Have children work on puzzles until class begins
- 2. Let each child put a sticker on their attendance chart
- 3. Have each child say the memory verse and put a sticker on their chart
- 4. Review the OT books of the bible (sing song)
- 5. Say a prayer (If any children want to lead a prayer let them)
- 6. Read story and let the children pretend to eat their vegetables
- 7. Help children with craft
- 8. Sing "My God Is So Big"

Scripture: Daniel 2

Memory Work: OT Books

Memory Verse: "... For He is the living God, and steadfast forever..." Daniel 6:26

(Goals and Objectives)

The children will learn:

- 1. Nebuchadnezzar had a bad dream that no one could interpret
- 2. Daniel and his friends prayed to God to help them
- 3. God told Daniel what the dream meant, and Daniel thanked God!
- 4. Daniel was able to tell Nebuchadnezzar about the dream and God's kingdom
- 5. The king believed in God and made Daniel ruler over Babylon

Application from Lesson:

We can influence others by trusting in the Lord

Materials Needed:

Color copy of statue, cut into strips Glue sticks for each child Construction paper for each child

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Have children work on puzzles until class begins
- 2. Let each child put a sticker on their attendance chart
- Have each child say the memory verse and put a sticker on their chart
- 4. Review the OT books of the bible (sing song)
- 5. Say a prayer (If any children want to lead a prayer let them)
- 6. Read the story to the children

Scripture: Daniel 3

Memory Work: OT Books

Memory Verse: "... For He is the living God, and steadfast forever..." Daniel 6:26

(Goals and Objectives) The children will learn:

- 1. King Nebuchadnezzar had a golden idol made that everyone was to worship
- 2. Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego would not kneel and worship the idol
- 3. The king threatened to throw them in the furnace but they weren't afraid because they knew God would take care of them
- 4. God sent an angel to protect them in the furnace
- 5. King Nebuchadnezzar made a law that no one could speak against their God

Application from Lesson:

God will take care of us when we stand up for what is right in His eyes

Materials Needed:

Cut out cardstock figures of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego Straws or popsicle sticks for each figure Paper lunch bags with a hole cut out (as a window into furnace) Clip art of flames, cut out

Order of Activities and Songs:

- 1. Have children work on puzzles until class begins
- 2. Let each child put a sticker on their attendance chart
- 3. Have each child say the memory verse and put a sticker on their chart
- 4. Review the OT books of the bible (sing song)
- 5. Say a prayer (If any children want to lead a prayer let them)
- 6. Read story to children from storybook
- 7. Help them with craft
- 8. Let the children play with the craft while reviewing the story

Explanation of Craft:

Tape the popsicle sticks or straws to the backs of the cardstock figures. Tape or glue flames to the bottom or the circle "window" on the paper lunch sack

Stick the figures up into the paper sack so that it looks like they are in the furnace
